10. A middle aged Romanian woman who has no visa and a 1 year old in her arms
11. A Skinhead from Sweden who is very drunk
12. A Dutch hard line and aggressive feminist
13. A wrestler from Belfast apparently going to a football match
14. A Polish prostitute from Berlin
15. A French farmer who only speaks French and has a basket full of strong cheese
16. A pro-Gaddafi Libyan refugee fleeing to Russia.
17. A Latvian priest returning from a pilgrimage.

## Instructions:

1. Individually select three people you DO want to share with, and three people you DO NOT want to share with.
2. In groups of 4 explain your 3 best and 3 worst companions, and discuss the reasons that led to your choices. Then try to come up with common list that you can all agree on for the 3 best and 3 worst companions.
3. All together the groups will present their results and their reasons for their choices.
